1. HEAR

2. PRAY

Prayerfully reflect on the new commandment: "love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." (John 13: 34)

Reflect on how God has loved you. In the past week what were some signs of God's love for you?

Give thanks to God for these signs of love.

Share with us how you are living out your faith at home. Use #LACatholicsBelieve and tag @LACatholics on social media.

Reflect on how you have loved others. In the past week, what were some ways you showed love for another person? Pray for those people.



If you felt that you have not lived out the new commandment fully, talk to God about what prevents you from loving others and ask God to make you a more loving person.

3. TALK

In the second reading, it says that God will make his home among his people (Revelation 21:3).

Each member of the family or community is to take a shape ([you can print this PDF](#) or create your own) and write how members can:

- Live out God's love
- Show respect and kindness
- Show another that they belong
- Examples: no fighting, listen to one another, sharing, etc.

Together, combine your shapes to create your home, a dwelling place, a home for God.
